



Property Maintenance in Wood Village



Grass, weeds and similar vegetation must be kept below 10 inches in height. The accumulation of solid waste including chunks of concrete is prohibited

Maintenance Overview

This brochure is an overview of City regulations that deal with common nuisance violations.

The City of Wood Village strives to have a safe, clean, livable community with a sense of pride, quality housing and strong identity.

- If you receive a violation notice from the City, contact the number listed in the notice so we can discuss the nature of the violation, and the options for correction.
- The City of Wood Village seeks to help improve the quality of life for all residents through a fair and efficient code compliance program that focuses on outreach and community education.

Common Maintenance Violations:

- The accumulation, collection or storage of solid waste, dirt, sand, gravel, or chunks of concrete.
- Solid waste includes garbage, rubbish, ashes, fill dirt, sewage sludge, street refuse, industrial wastes, swill, demolition and used construction materials, abandoned vehicles or parts, discarded home or industrial appliances, and other discarded solid materials.
- The outdoor storage or display of indoor furniture.
- Parking or storage of vehicles on grassy or bare soil surfaces
- The parking or storage of vehicles that appear to be junked, inoperable, or abandoned.
- Uncontrolled or uncultivated growth of weeds, brush, or grasses over 10 inches in height.
- Dead or decaying trees and tree limbs that present a safety hazard.



Vehicles must be parked on paved or gravel surfaces. Vehicles that appear to be inoperable, junked, discarded or abandoned must be stored indoors
