STANDARD CONDITIONS FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT

1. Inspections are required. Call (503) 489-6861 (day) or (503) 489-6860 (evening) a minimum of 24 hours in advance, or fax in advance to (503) 669-8723.
2. Any changes made to the permit by any agency other than Wood Village Public Works, will cause the permit to become null and void.
3. The City of Wood Village retains the right to change the Right-of-Way Permit granted and order the relocation or adjustment of lines, manholes, access ports, fixtures, and apparatus hereby assigned to be installed, whenever, in the opinion of the City, this becomes necessary; and desirable and in the event that such an order is made, all changes pursuant thereto shall be made at the sole expense of the permittee.
4. Proper signs, barriers, barricades, and lights shall be placed and maintained in accordance with the latest manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, as published by the U.S. Department of Transportation.
5. The permit does not authorize closure of any road or street, unless specifically stated on the permit.
6. Call before you dig 1-800-332-2344 for underground service alert.
7. For location of traffic signal conduits and interconnects call Multnomah County, Oregon.
8. For location of street light conduits call PGE.
9. Traffic or street signs of any kind are not to be moved for any reason without first obtaining permission from the Wood Village Public Works Division.
10. All work authorized by the permit shall conform to applicable City ordinances, municipal codes, and the Public Works Design and Construction Standards.
11. No open trench shall be allowed across any street or within ten feet (10') of any travel-way, except when work is in actual progress. Open trenches shall be plated with temporary ramps at all other times.
12. **A temporary roadway patch is to be placed, and is to be maintained by the permittee. A permanent roadway patch is to be in place within 15 days thereafter.**
13. Compaction tests are required for base rock and asphalt.
14. When issued, the permit must be on the job site at all times.
15. A traffic control plan approved by the Department of Public Works ensuring the work will not unreasonably interfere with vehicular and pedestrian traffic, the demand and necessity for parking spaces, and the ingress and egress from the affected or adjacent properties and rights-of-way is required. (This information may be provided as a sketch on 8 ½" x 11" paper. All utility work will require approval by the applicable agency).

AS APPLICANT FOR A RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT TO DO THE ABOVE DESCRIBED WORK, I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE "STANDARD CONDITIONS FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT", AS STATED ABOVE, AND ANY SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE ROADS AND STREETS THAT MAY BE PLACED ON THE ACTUAL PERMIT FOR THIS WORK IN THE CITY OF WOOD VILLAGE RIGHT-OF-WAY.
